Dear partners,

Greeting from Nottingham China campus! I hope this email find you and your family are all in good health.

Although student visa application is still not resumed, we have been working with governments to welcome our international students. However, due to the changing situation of COVID-19 worldwide, it still takes time. We will keep you updated once there is any information from the government. The mobility program for next academic year 21/22 will remain unchanged and we still look forward to receiving nominations from your university.

Scholarships for exchange students

1. Global Ambassador Scholarship

The new scholarship is to recognize the contribution of incoming exchange students from UNNC global partners who actively engaged with Global Engagement Office in promoting UNNC exchange, PGT and PGR programme to their fellow students in home university and home country. 10-15 places will be launched as a start from this September, successful applicants will be offered RMB 5,000 each for their exchange study period at UNNC. 50% of scholarship will be paid at the beginning of semester and the rest of 50% will be paid at the end of term when students' contribution been satisfied.

2. Ningbo International Student Government Scholarship for Academic Excellence

The winners will be awarded a one-off payment of RMB3,000 per semester. Students need to prepare some paperwork and apply via UNNC Global Engagement Office. Further information about scholarship place/required documents will be released to your nominated students once we received confirmation from local government during summer vocation.

3. UNNC mobility scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded *to both exchange and study abroad students* (not including Nottingham UK and Malaysia campuses). We are happy to announce RMB 500,000 scholarship to 19/20 incoming students. Winners will be selected by their academic performance at home university and the success ratio will be around 50% of total nomination you send to us. The winners will be awarded a one-off payment of RMB 6,000 each.

4. Ningbo Government Scholarship for Non-degree Students from HMT Area

Ningbo government offers non-degree students from Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan a scholarship up to RMB 6,000 each. HMT office will provide scholarship information and quota after students successfully registered at UNNC.
