Attached please find a letter from Director Elizabeth Perry, inviting your institution to participate in the HYI **Joint Scholarship Program**, which provides the funding for your young faculty to pursue a Ph.D. at the National University of Singapore (NUS), with a year of dissertation research/writing at Harvard University. The application process for this program is different from the Visiting Scholars application process. Candidates do not apply using HYI's online application system.
