- 5. Applicants who have knowledge of 3D Media Design, Animation Design, Animation, Computer game creation, Interactive Media in computer science, computer engineering, Artificial Intelligence, or other related fields will be considered specially.
- 6. Graduated from the institution accredited by the Thai Civil Service Commission.
- 7. Candidates with doctoral qualifications must have the following qualifications,
 - 7.1. Must graduate from a university accredited by the Academic Council; and
 - 7.2.English proficiency, TOEFL minimum score of 550 (paper-based / ITP) or 196 (computer-based) or 80 (internet-based), or IELTS minimum score of 6.0, or CMU eTEGS minimum score of 80.
 - 7.3. The applicants who graduated from the countries where English is an official language such as the United Kingdom, the United State of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, etc., are exempt from the English Proficiency qualification requirement according to the Chiang Mai University decree of New Academic Lecturer's general English qualification and practice, 2017 (B.E.2560).
- 8. Applicants with a master's degree who are in the process of pursuing a Doctoral/ Ph.D. must have the following qualifications;
 - 8.1.Must graduate from a university accredited by the Academic Council and have received a master's degree grade point average of at least 3.5, **except for** those who are studying for a doctoral degree (foreign country) or international program will be exempt from GPA; and.
 - 8.2.Must completed a master's degree from an accredited university ranked in the world's top 500 which is ranked by recognized institutions, namely QS World University Rankings or Times Higher Education World University Rankings, including graduates from Chiang Mai University (if graduating from an institute that is not ranked in the world's top 500 the Faculty of Fine Arts must propose to the Academic Council for consideration before proposing to Chiang Mai University for approval); and,
 - 8.3.English proficiency, TOEFL minimum score of 550 (paper-based / ITP) or 196 (computer-based) or 80 (internet-based), or have a minimum IELTS score 6.0, or CMU eTEGS minimum score of 80, except for those who are studying doctoral studies (foreign countries) or international programs will be exempted English proficiency

9. If the applicant is a foreigner must submit a proficiency test in Thai language (Thai Competency Test) on the date of application submission or submit a copy of the certificate through the Thai communication skills training course for at least 60 hours.
